

We began to see changes in the market as early as January 2018 when pending sales declined for both condominiums and single family homes. In March the median sales price of condos hit a record high of \$435,000. We saw the record median sales price for single family homes reach \$812,500 in September. By April new listings for single family houses began to outpace the prior year and pending sales steadily declined. The year ended with just a 2.9% **increase** in new single family home listings and a 16.1% **decrease** in pending sales. Condos fared better with a 4.6% **increase** in new listings and a **decrease** of 10.7% in pending sales. This is reflected in a 12.5% **increase** in days on market for single family homes and 17.6% **increase** for condos.

What's Ahead in 2019?

FOR BUYERS: Increased inventory and moderating sales give buyers more choices and the luxury of more time to make decisions.

Economists expect rising interest rates resulting in reduced buying power for borrowers. Consider purchasing sooner than later.

Cash buyers will have more choices as the buyer pool may be restricted by rising interest rates. It's a great time to consider adding an investment property or re-aligning your real estate portfolio.

More project developments are expected in Ala Moana, Kakaako, Moiliili, and Hawaii Kai. Lock in today's prices for a unit to be constructed 2-3 years from now.

The median sales prices of homes and condos located outside the metropolitan area of Honolulu are considerably less. Consider purchasing outside metro Honolulu to get more house value for your money.
